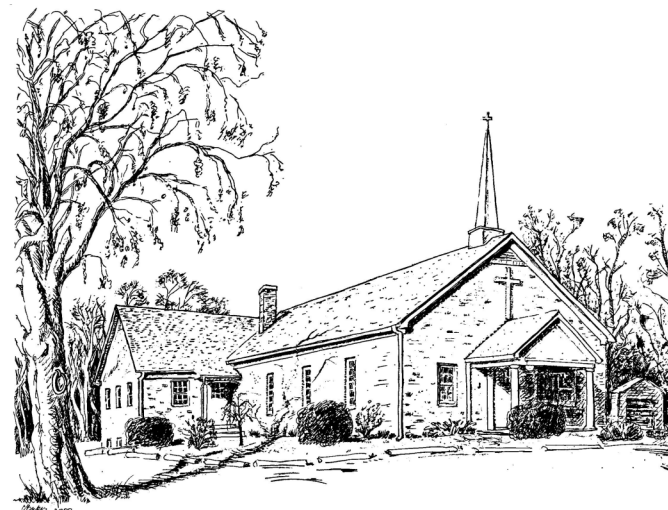
## Psalm 18:1-2

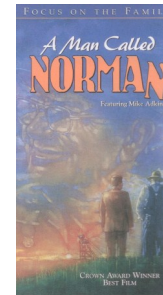
